OBJECT DESCRIPTION ACTIVITY – FMS II

The Object Description activity was conducted to develop observation skills and oral expression. Children described different classroom objects by identifying their color, size, shape, and use. This activity enhanced vocabulary, sentence formation, and confidence in speaking, while also improving cognitive and descriptive abilities.



ART EXPLORATION ACTIVITY – FMS III

Students of FMS III participated in an Art Exploration session designed to enhance creativity, imagination, and self-expression. Through different art materials, textures, and techniques, children explored colors, shapes, and patterns. The activity strengthened fine motor skills, artistic confidence, and appreciation for creative work.



REMEDIAL CLASSES FOR SLOW LEARNERS

During February, special remedial classes were arranged for students who required additional academic support. These sessions focused on strengthening foundational concepts in literacy, numeracy, and phonics through individualized attention, repetition, and activity-based learning. Teachers used simplified instructions, concrete materials, and guided practice to help students build confidence and overcome learning gaps. The initiative ensured that every child progressed at their own pace while receiving the support needed to achieve academic success.



MATHEMATICS ESTIMATION ACTIVITY -GRADE 1

Grade 1 students enjoyed a hands-on estimation activity using concrete materials. They first estimated the quantity, then counted to check their answers. This helped them develop number sense and made Maths learning fun and meaningful.



MATHEMATICS ACTIVITY: EXPLORING 3D SHAPES -GRADE 1

Grade 1 students learned to specialize in comparing 3D shapes by identifying their properties. They also generalized their learning by finding these shapes in real-life objects around them. This activity helped students connect Math with the world around them in an engaging way.



ART ACTIVITY: CREPE PAPER COLLAGE- GRADE 2

Grade 2 students enjoyed creating beautiful collage work using crepe paper. They explored colors, textures, and shapes while carefully pasting the paper to complete their artwork. This activity enhanced their creativity and fine motor skills, and students were proud to present their colorful creations.



SCIENCE ACTIVITY: LIGHT AND SHADOW- GRADE 2

Grade 2 students learned the science concepts of light and shadow through engaging activities. They explored how shadows are formed when light is blocked and observed different shadow sizes and shapes. This helped students understand the importance of light in our daily life in a fun and practical way.


CREATIVE MINDS UNLEASHED


CELEBRATING JASHN-E-ANWAR-E-SHABAN

EVENTS

The Vitamin A and Polio Vaccination Campaign was successfully conducted for eligible students in coordination with the concerned health authorities. The campaign was organized efficiently with proper documentation, consent procedures, and adherence to safety protocols, ensuring smooth implementation and complete coverage.



PSYCHOLOGICAL CASE OBSERVATION & PROFESSIONAL SUPERVISION

A structured individual observation session was conducted with a Montessori student as part of a special case review and to model comprehensive behavioral assessment practices for the counseling team. Through a guided creative task with mild challenges, areas such as attention span, impulse control, frustration tolerance, task persistence, and response to redirection were carefully observed using supportive prompts and positive reinforcement. The session provided meaningful insight into the child's emotional regulation and behavioral responses, while also serving as a practical supervision opportunity to strengthen counselors' observation skills and ensure developmentally appropriate support planning.



COUNSELING & SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL SUPPORT - FMS

The FMS Student Counsellor conducted a group session on emotional expression, where students explored their feelings through color-based drawing in a supportive environment, promoting creativity and open communication. Individual sessions were also held to develop impulse control and turn-taking skills through structured play, fostering patience, self-regulation, and positive peer interactions.

Classroom wellness sessions were conducted in which students participated in Role Play activities. Students were divided into groups and acted out scenarios on topics such as “Bullying is Not Cool,” “Self-Confidence,” “Real vs Fake Friends,” “Anger Control-Pause Button,” and “Study vs Phone.” Through these role plays, students explored their thoughts, feelings, and behaviors in real-life situations, which helped them develop self-awareness, practice empathy, and reflect on personal strengths and emotional responses. The activity encouraged collaboration, communication, and positive social skills among students.
