A WELL-DESERVED FUN DAY








UNDERSTANDING THE CAMBRIDGE APPROACH

MID-TERM EXAMINATIONS



PARENT-TEACHER COLLABORATION



MAINTAINING STANDARDS: NOTEBOOK EVALUATIONS & CROS



CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTION CEREMONY:


Value Department distributed certificates to the students of class IX and X with regards to their participation and achievement in Character Education's Theme "Media Literacy".



WEEKLY ASSEMBLY PRESENTATION:


In the weekly presentation, a 5-minute refreshing session was conducted on various topics, in which the students participated with great interest.

CELEBRATION OF WILADAT-E-BIBI FATIMA (S.A.):



HEALTH AWARENESS & WELL-BEING INITIATIVES








INSIGHT-BUILDING SESSION WITH SECONDARY STUDENTS
