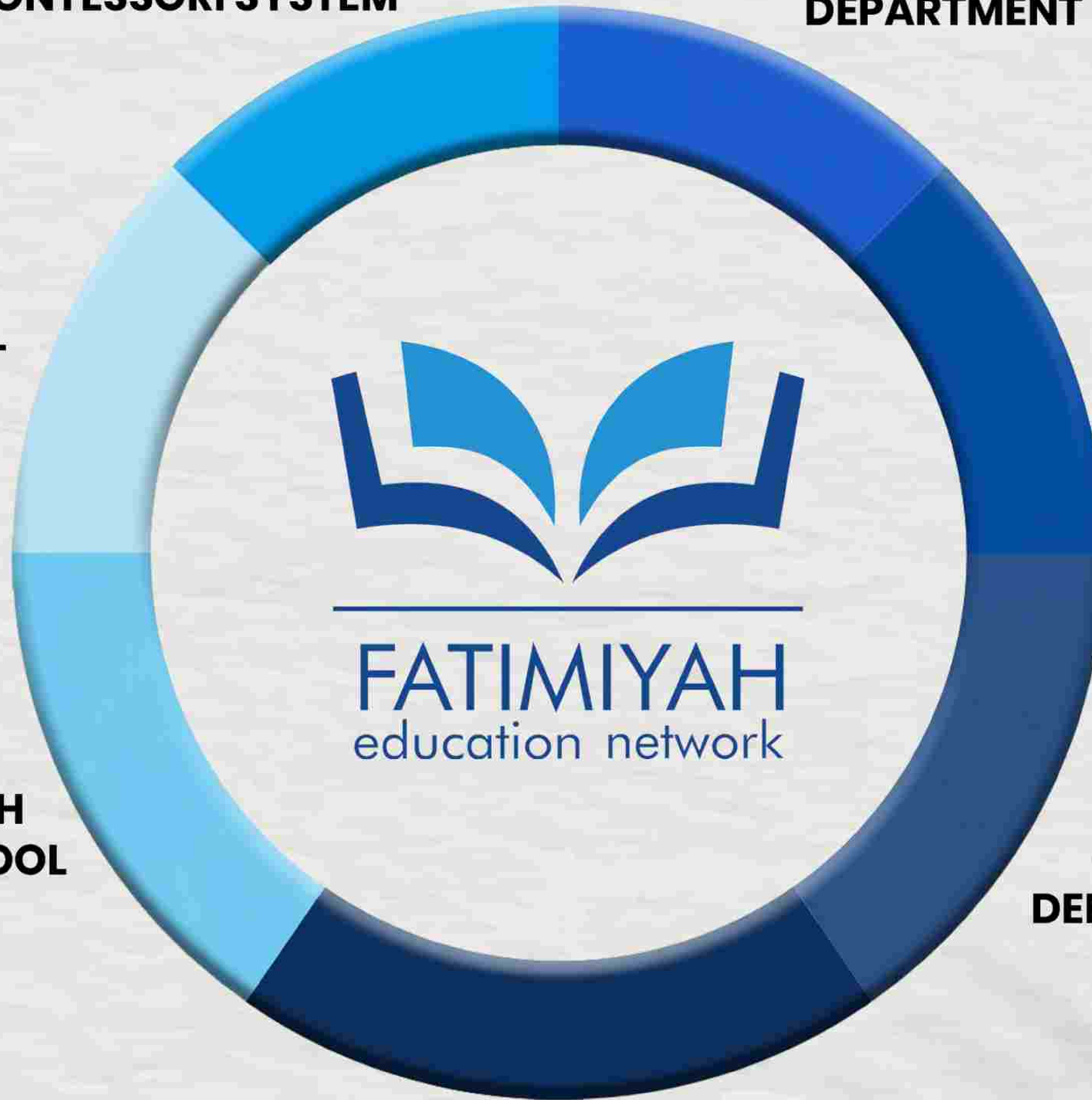

## Cognitive Mapping

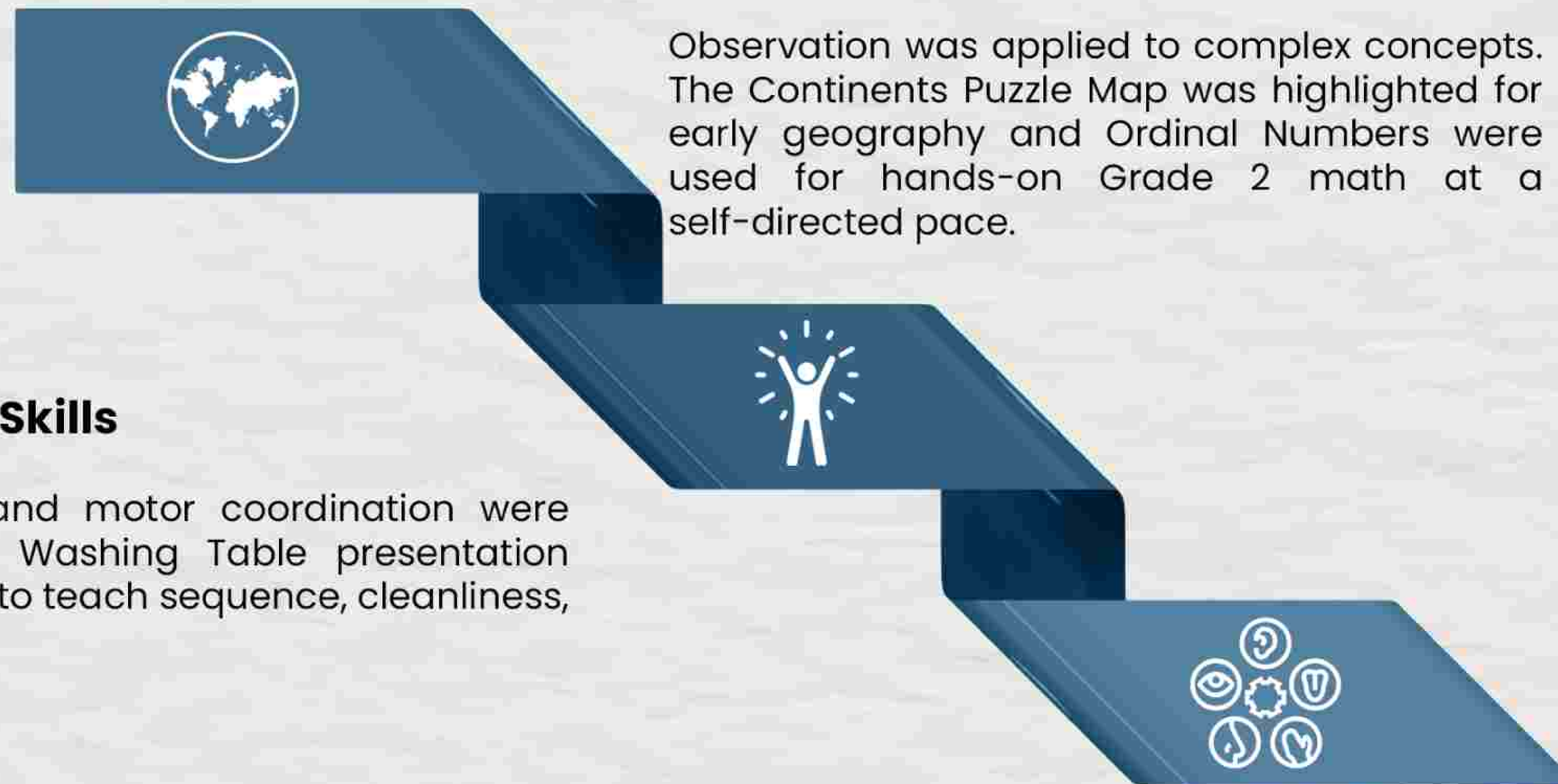
Observation was applied to complex concepts. The Continents Puzzle Map was highlighted for early geography and Ordinal Numbers were used for hands-on Grade 2 math at a self-directed pace.

## Practical Life Skills

Independence and motor coordination were developed. The Washing Table presentation was highlighted to teach sequence, cleanliness, and self-care.

## Sensory Refinement

Hands-on exploration built concentration. Thermic Tablets were featured for differentiating temperature and Knobless Cylinders were used for differentiating sizes, diameters, and heights to build mathematical foundations.

# FGS & FBS: The Hybrid Learning Pivot

**Context:** With both campuses designated as official SSC Examination Centres, FEN rapidly deployed tailored online learning frameworks to ensure zero academic disruption for Grades 3-8.

## Fatimiyah Girls' School

### Asynchronous Focus

Leveraged Google Classroom through pre-recorded lesson videos and daily targeted worksheets. This allowed students to revise and practice at their own pace while building independent study habits during the center operations.

## Fatimiyah Boys' School

### Synchronous Focus

Conducted interactive live Zoom sessions from March 24th-31st, paired with Google Classroom assignment tracking. This approach offered dynamic engagement, real-time feedback, and structured daily touchpoints.

**Execution Milestone:** Execution Milestone: Comprehensive orientation workshops were held for all Grade 3-8 students to build digital literacy and platform autonomy.



# Academic & Extracurricular Triumphs

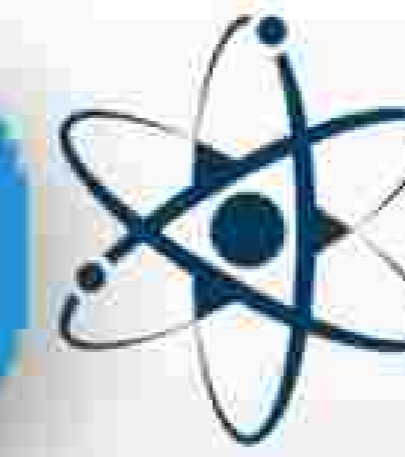
## Public Speaking Mastery

FMS III undertook specialized preparation focusing on two and three-letter words to seamlessly bridge into the Grade I Nazra curriculum.



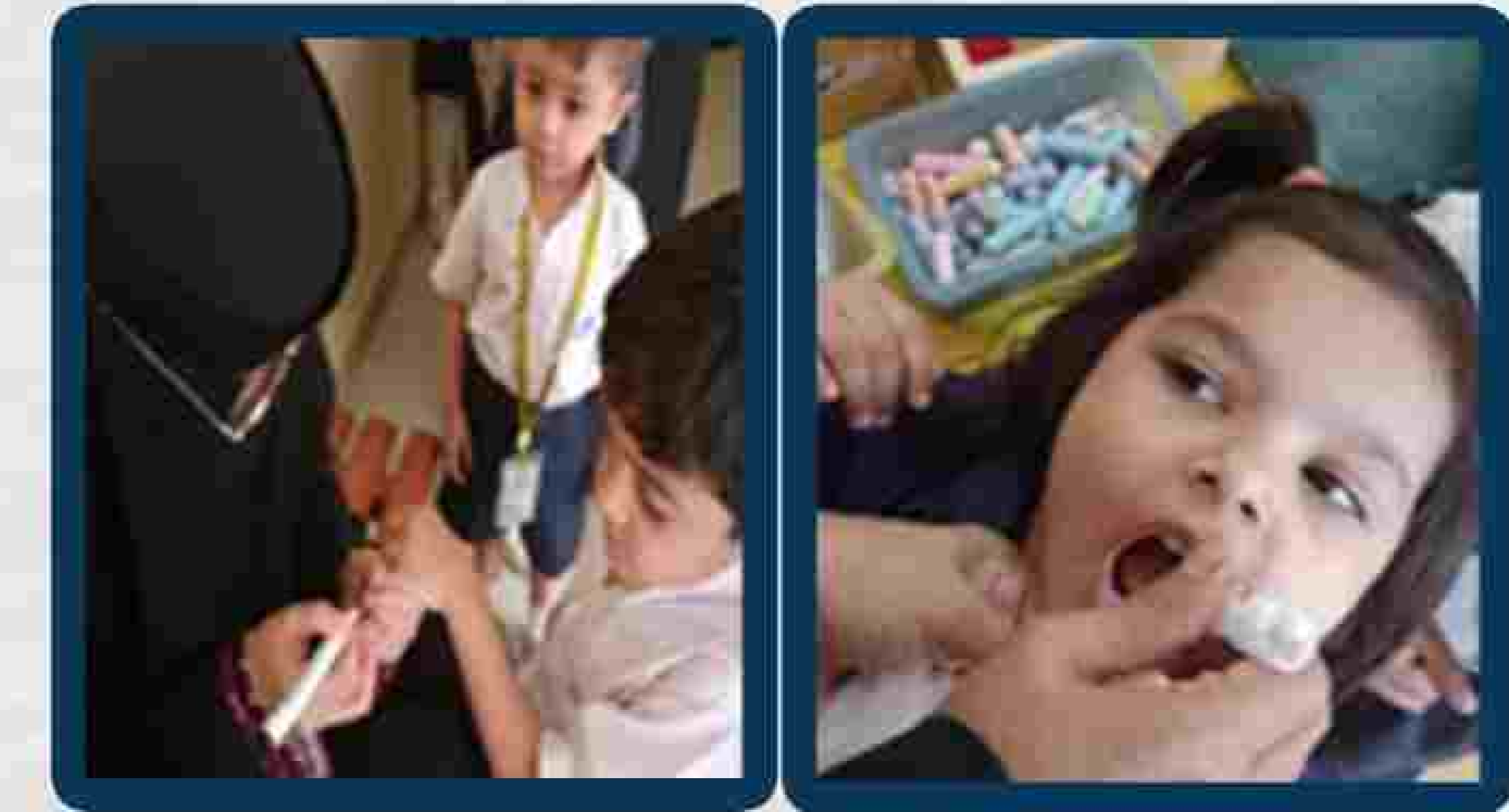
# Health & Psychological Well-being

Combined FBS/FGS CPD titled 'Architecting Scientific Minds' focused on GCSE-based assessment objectives, designed high-quality questions, and accurately applied examiner marking schemes.

PD&QA refined the 2026-2027 Scheme of Studies and actively collaborated with the Psychology Department to gather teacher feedback for the upcoming Summer Learning Program (SLP 3.0).

Successful Test 2 Parent-Teacher Meetings provided a crucial platform to review academic results and align parents with the hybrid online learning pivot.

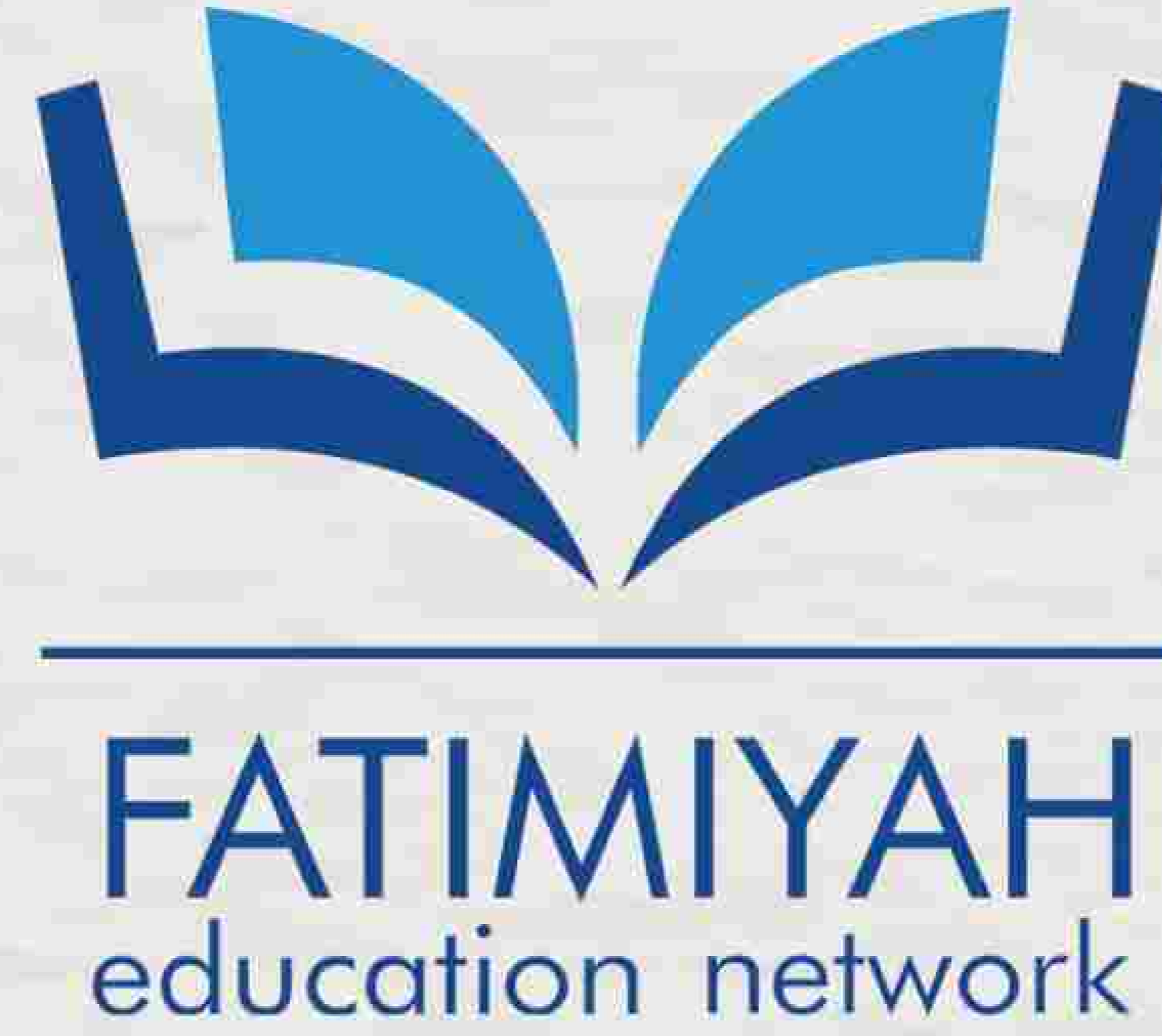
